The purpose of this training is to educate employees, employers, managers and human resource representatives about the laws that prohibit discrimination in employment.

SUMMARY OF TRAINING

The Kentucky Civil Rights Act (KRS 344) prohibits employers, employment agencies, and labor organization from discriminating against a person on the basis of disability, race, color, religion, national origin, smoking, sex (including pregnancy & sexual harassment), and age (40 years and over). The training will also cover the process of filing a complaint at the Kentucky Commission on Human Rights.
