CITY OF BEREA, KY CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Ordinance # 11-13 (Summarized)

The term "fireworks" shall mean any composition or device for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by conbustion, deflagration or detonation and which meets the definition of "common" or "special" fireworks as set forth in the United States Department of Transportation's hazardous materials regulations.*

- Consumer fireworks may only be used, ignited, fired or exploded between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. except on the following dates, when the applicable ending hour shall be 12:00 a.m. (midnight):
 - 1) December 31st
 - 2) July 3rd
 - 3) July 4th
 - 4) Memorial Day
 - 5) The date specifically named or designated by the City Council as the date to celebrate Independence Daly, if other than the actual date of July 4th.
- No person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age may use, ignite, fire or explode any consumer fireworks.
- No person may use ignite, fire or explode any consumer fireworks within two hundred feet of any structure.
- No person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age permitted to sell fireworks.
- No person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age permitted to buy fireworks.
- Any person convicted of a violation under Ordinance # 11-13 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500.
