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EXECUTIVE ORDER #2021-11

<u>Implementation of Emergency Procedures for Payment of City of Berea, Kentucky of Occupational</u> License Fee on Net Profits

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020 President Donald J. Trump declared a national state of emergency in response to the coronavirus, COVID-19, pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020 Governor Andy Beshear declared a state of emergency in Kentucky in response to the first documented case of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020 I issued an emergency declaration for the City of Berea, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the impact of the pandemic and recommended actions from Federal, State and Local authorities continues to create a financial hardship on some Businesses operating in Berea, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the United States Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service are providing special payment relief to individuals and businesses in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW and therefore, I, Bruce Fraley, Mayor of the City of Berea, Kentucky, pursuant to the authority granted in KRS83A.130(4) and KRS39A.100, hereby order the following actions:

The City of Berea will extend the filing deadline and due date for payments for the Occupational License Fees on Net Profits from April 15, 2021 until May 17, 2021.

This order shall remain in effect until terminated by the issuance of another Executive Order when I determine that a state of emergency no longer exists, and the exercise of extraordinary measures are no longer required for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare.
