ORDINANCE 13 - 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEREA, KENTUCKY, DECLARING A CERTAIN FIRE ENGINE TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE VEHICLE TO BE DONATED TO THE BEREA VOLUNTEER FIREMAN'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

The City Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

That a certain vehicle, being a 2001 FL70 Freightliner, Cummins Engine, Hale QfFL0125-19 1250GPM Pump, manufactured by EONE SO# 125610, VIN 1FVABXB522HK13000, which was acquired for use as a fire engine, is hereby declared surplus because it is no longer suitable for use by the Fire Department considering the cost to maintain and insure it, so that it is in the public interest to dispose of such vehicle, and the Mayor is authorized and directed to dispose of same by transferring it without consideration to the Berea Volunteer Firemen's Association, Inc., pursuant to KRS 82.083, on the specific conditions (i) that the recipient shall keep and maintain the apparatus in good physical condition, and pump tested, for use in fire control operations of the Berea Volunteer Firemen's Association; and (ii) that in the event that the Berea Volunteer Firemen's Association, Inc., no longer has need of the donated fire engine, same shall be returned to the City of Berea, and the Berea Volunteer Firemen's Association, Inc., shall not sell, give, assign, or convey the fire engine to any person or entity whatsoever other than the City of Berea.

SECTION II

All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
