**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BEREHA, KENTUCKY,  
LENDING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES TO THE CITY OF HAZARD, KENTUCKY,  
SUBSEQUENT TO THE LOSS OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY THE CITY OF HAZARD IN  
A CATASTROPHIC FLOOD ON JULY**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Hazard, Kentucky, has suffered catastrophic flood damage from a flood on July 28-29, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hazard suffered a loss of municipal motor vehicles in such flood; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bereha has four surplus motor vehicles which are suitable for use by the City of Hazard subsequent to the loss of vehicles by the City of Hazard; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bereha will be considering a Municipal Order to transfer such surplus motor vehicles to the City of Hazard to replace vehicles lost in the flood; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hazard is in immediate need of the motor vehicles prior to the next meeting of the Bereha City Council, and I believe it is an emergency warranting immediate action;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Pursuant to my authority as Mayor of the City of Bereha, the following listed motor vehicles shall be lent to the City of Hazard, Kentucky, for municipal use only, for a period until the City Council of the City of Bereha shall enact a Municipal Order declaring the vehicles as surplus and directing their transfer to the City of Hazard:


- a. 2005 Chevrolet Trailblazer, obtained for and used by the Codes Department, VIN 1GNOT135952347972.
  - b. 2006 Ford Escape, obtained for and used by the Codes Department, VIN 1FMYU93176KA36924
  - c. 2005 Chevrolet Trailblazer, obtained for and used by Administration, VIN 1GNDT13S852288168
  - d. 2011 Ford Crown Victoria, obtained for and used by Police Department, VIN 2FABP7BV4BX1433565
2. The loan of the vehicles is conditioned on the City of Hazard's agreement to (i) utilize the motor vehicles for municipal purposes only, (ii) provide appropriate liability insurance for the use of the vehicles, and (iii) in the event that the City Council of the City of Berea does not approve a Municipal Order transferring such motor vehicles to the City of Hazard, to return the motor vehicles to the City of Berea upon request.

This Order shall take effect immediately.


