EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27 -2022**

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BEREHA, KENTUCKY, LENDING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES TO THE WOLF COAL VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, SUBSEQUENT TO THE LOSSES BY WOLF COAL AND THE NEEDS OF THE BREATHITT COUNTY COMMUNITY SUBSEQUENT TO A CATASTROPHIC FLOOD BETWEEN JULY 25-JULY 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, Breathitt County, Kentucky, and the Wolf Coal community in Breathitt County, have suffered catastrophic flood damage from a flood on July 28-29, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Breathitt County and the Wolf Coal Community are in desperate need of continuing fire protection subsequent to such flood; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bereha has a surplus a surplus tanker truck which is suitable for use by the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department is recognized by the Kentucky Fire Commission and is under the supervision of the Breathitt Fiscal Court so that such fire department constitutes a governmental agency within the meaning of KRS 82.083; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bereha will be considering a Municipal Order to transfer such surplus motor vehicle to the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department to supplement its fire protection equipment subsequent to the flood; and

WHEREAS, Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department is in immediate need of the motor vehicle prior to the next meeting of the Bereha City Council, and I believe it is an emergency warranting immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to my authority as Mayor of the City of Bereha, the following listed motor vehicle shall be lent to the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department for public

fire protection use only, for a period until the City Council of the City of Berea shall enact a Municipal Order declaring the vehicle as surplus and directing its transfer to the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department:

1994- 4700 International, VIN1HTSCAA8SH644998
Gorman Rupp 400GPM Pump
1850 gallon water tank
2000 gallon dump tank

2. The loan of the vehicle is conditioned on the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department's agreement to (i) utilize the motor vehicle for public fire protection purposes only, (ii) provide appropriate liability insurance for the use of the vehicles, and (iii) in the event that the City Council of the City of Berea does not approve a Municipal Order transferring such motor vehicle to the Wolf Coal Volunteer Fire Department, to return the motor vehicle to the City of Berea upon request.


This Order shall take effect immediately.
