EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022 - 29**

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BERA RESCINDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-06 PROVIDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR BERA MUNICIPAL UTILITIES BILLING AND PAYMENT**

**WHEREAS**, a national state of emergency was declared on March 13, 2020 in response to the coronavirus, COVID-19, pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, a state of emergency was declared on March 6, 2020, in Kentucky by Governor Andy Beshear in response to the first documented case of the coronavirus, COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, Bruce Fraley, Mayor of the City of Berea issued Executive Order No. 2020-06 providing that the Berea Municipal Utilities would temporarily suspend the disconnection of water, sewer and electric service for non-payment for all customers; temporarily waive charging a “convenience fee” for online payments with credit or debit cards for all customers; and temporarily waive late fees for all water, sewer and gas customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the national state of emergency and the state of emergency declared in Kentucky has now been lifted;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bruce Fraley, Mayor of the City of Berea, pursuant to the authority granted in KRS 83a.130(3) and other applicable law, hereby Order as follows:

- 1) The provisions of Executive Order No. 2020-06 be and the same are hereby repealed.
- 2) Berea Municipal Utilities shall reinstate its disconnection of service policy for non-payment of water, sewer and electric service for all customers.
- 3) Berea Municipal Utilities shall reinstate its late fee assessment for all water, sewer and electric customers.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
