



STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION

Simple actions protect Berea's streams.

Stormwater runoff is not treated before it enters local waterways. Everyday activities around homes, streets, parking lots, and work sites can carry pollutants into the storm drain system.

Common Sources of Stormwater Pollution	Easy Ways to Help Protect Our Streams
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Litter and trash• Oil, grease, and vehicle fluids• Yard waste and grass clippings• Pet waste• Sediment from disturbed soil and construction sites• Soaps, paint, or household chemicals	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Never dump anything into a storm drain• Bag trash and recyclables and keep containers closed• Sweep up leaves and grass instead of pushing them into the street• Fix vehicle leaks and dispose of fluids properly• Pick up after pets every time• Report spills or illegal dumping to the City of Berea

***Storm drains flow directly to local waterways.
Only rain should enter the storm drain system.***
